

REWANUI FOREST PARK

Rewanui Forest Park is owned by the Montfort Trimble Foundation, a Masterton-based charity dedicated to growing trees for public benefit. There's lots going on at Rewanui – native forest management and conservation, plantation forestry, tree trials, and sheep and beef farming.

We are big on pest control to encourage native birds, animals and insects, and trees and plants, to survive. Birds you might see or hear include tui, bellbirds, kereru, grey warblers, fantails and many more.

We are also growing many different species of trees, both natives and exotics, to learn more about them.

This is a working forest and farm.

Please observe the following guidelines:

- Please sign in and sign out of the Visitors Book
- Leave the gates as you find them
- Dogs are welcome but must be on a lead
- Keep to marked trails
- No fires or smoking
- No firearms or hunting
- Take litter home with you



ENJOY A WALK ON ONE OF OUR TRACKS

Matai and Tōtara Loops

If you enjoy a good bush walk, take the Matai or Tōtara Loop tracks. You will encounter some magnificent old trees as well as rich variety of smaller trees and understorey plants. The Matai Loop is steep in places, so stick to the Tōtara Loop if you prefer an easier gradient.

Exotics Loop

For a walk with views and variety, try the Exotics Loop. This walk takes you across farmland, through regenerating bush, and then past some of our exotic demonstration plantings. Species you will see include redwoods, cypresses, cedar, eucalypts, firs and larches. The Exotics Loop is gentle gradient.

Mt Clyde Trig Track

The Mt Clyde Trig Track provides a challenging uphill climb at a steady gradient. You will be rewarded with fantastic views, but be warned, it gets pretty windy up there! You can return the way you came, take a diversion via the Matai Loop, or complete a longer circuit via the east side of the trig.

Natives Loop

This track is accessed from the end of the Purunui Track. Look for our native plantation timber trials, which are planted around this track. The track is steep and slippery in parts and can be wet in winter.

Purunui Track

An easy benched road through the pine forest passing a couple of ponds along the way.

Trials Loops

The Trials Loops are accessed off the Exotics Loop. The track travels past Manuka trials and a durable Eucalypt species trial. You will see some good timber trees and some that will never make the grade as a timber plantation tree.

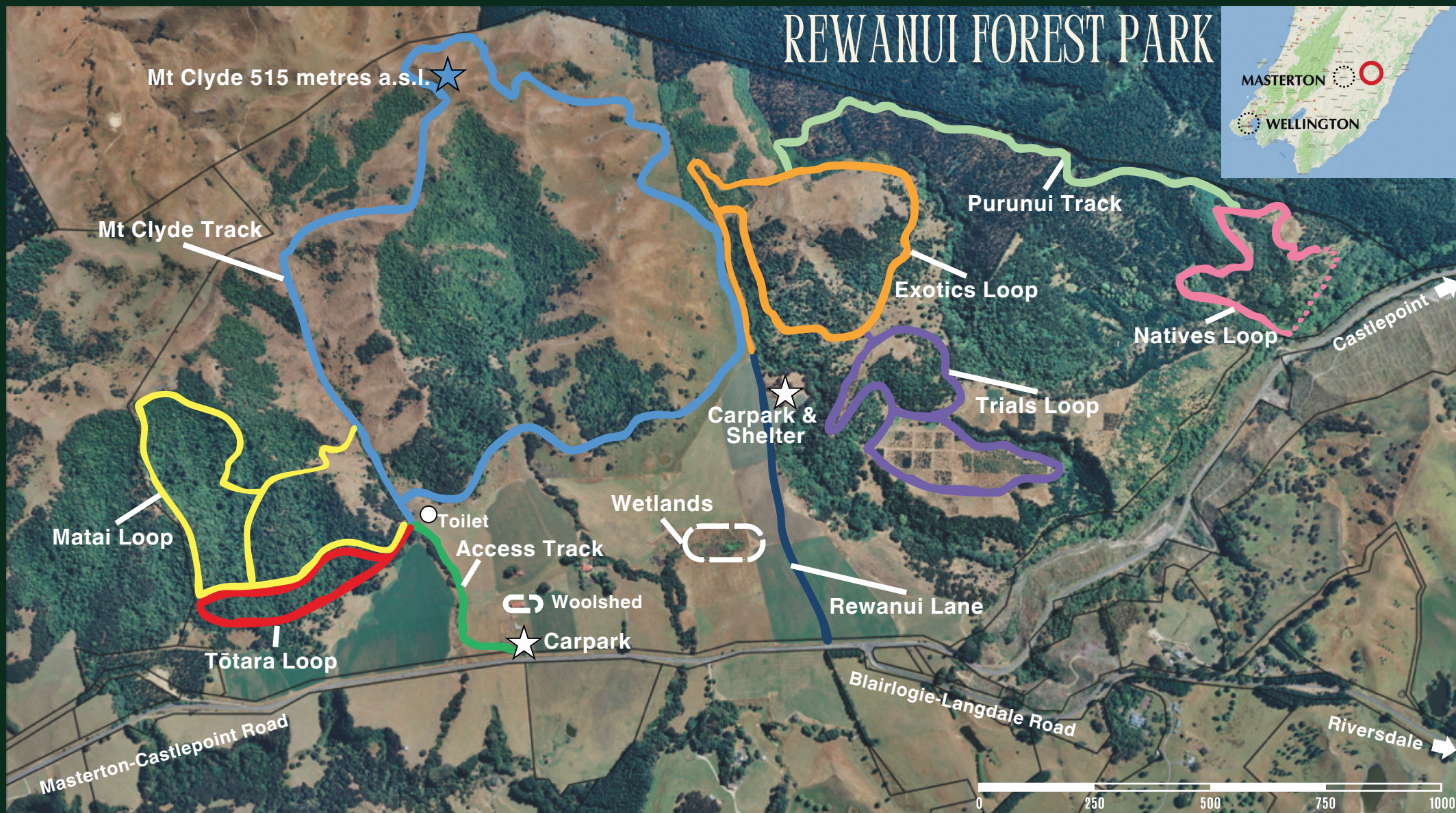
Welcome to Rewanui Forest Park.

WALKING TRACKS

- Access Track – 10 mins, easy
- Tōtara Loop – ¾ hour, moderate
- Matai Loop – 1¼ hours, moderate-steep
- Mt Clyde Track – 2 hours, exposed, moderate
- Exotics Loop – 1½ hours, easy
- Natives Loop – 1 hour, moderate-hard, steep
- Purunui Track – 1 hour return, easy
- Trials Loops – ¾ hour, easy
- Rewanui Lane
